* Upon successful completion of a nine week pre-service training program, appointment to the position of Correctional Officer (40 hr. work week) will be at the annual salary range noted above. During the nine weeks of training, Correctional Officer Trainees will receive a base rate of \$500 per week without benefits. Successful completion of the pre-service training program is required to obtain permanent status as a Correctional Officer.

DUTIES: A Correctional Officer is responsible for the supervision, custody and control of adult inmates incarcerated at the Adult Correctional facilities in Cranston, Rhode Island.

EDUCATION & EXPERIENCE: HS Diploma/GED and employment in a private or public agency involving the supervision of others and the enforcement of rules and regulations; or, a substantially equivalent combination of education and experience.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Must be certified as physically and mentally qualified to perform the above duties after passing a physical fitness test and medical and psychological examination conducted by a licensed physician and psychologist; must also pass a comprehensive pre-screening process including a nationwide criminal records check and detailed background investigation.
