VISITOR INFORMATION SHEET

**A: Visiting limitations:**

- 1) 2 - Adult visitor limit during visits. 2 - Child limit if any children are not the inmate's children.
- 2) No limit on number of children if all children are inmate's children.

**B: If inmate is unavailable for a visit:**

- 1) Reception Officer will notify visitors if inmate is in segregation. Reception Officer will attempt to give visitor date that inmate is released from segregation.
- 2) Inmate's who are on 2 - nighters will be responsible to notify their visitors.

**C: Visitor Check-In Procedure**

- 1) Proper ID required. Valid driver's license, valid military ID, valid passport, valid Dept. of Transportation ID, valid Elderly Affairs ID, and valid State ID are the only accepted ID.
- 2) Visitors must pass through metal detector. Only three attempts to pass the metal detector are allowed. Visitors cannot leave the reception area in-between attempts to pass metal detector.
- 3) Visitors are allowed to carry 1 key (locker or vehicle), ID, handkerchief, wedding/engagement ring, and up to \$10.00 in change in a clear plastic bag.
- 4) Coats and hats may be worn on the way to the visiting room but must be searched prior to entry.
- 5) All pockets will be turned inside out for visual inspection.
- 6) Visitors must open mouths for visual search.

**D: Conveying Contraband:**

- 1) Any visitor found conveying contraband (weapons, drugs, alcohol, controlled substances, ECT.) may be subject to possible loss of visiting privileges and criminal prosecution, with legal penalty if convicted.

**E:** No property, paperwork, food, drink or any item not listed above, are allowed into a visit.

**F:** Minor children are subject to all searches and procedures as the adults.

**G:** Parents and adult guardians must appear in person to give someone else permission to accompany their children/guardians for visits. All ID, birth certificates, guardianship papers, and court orders must be shown for permission to be granted.

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**XII. Visitors' Dress Code**

A. Following are the rules and regulations regarding proper attire for visitors to the John J. Moran Medium Security Facility: These standards apply to children over the age of twelve (12).

- No spandex, stirrup, or sweat pants, swishy pants, or any other tight-fitting or athletic type clothing.
- No low-cut, V-neck sweaters or blouses
- No sleeveless shirts or blouses
- No see-through clothing of any kind
- No blouses or shirts too short to tuck in or those which expose the midriff
- No clothes with holes, rips, tears, or which in any way allow access to the skin
- No tank tops or halter tops
- No farmer jeans with metal buckles
- No skirts or dresses with slits that reach two inches or more above the knee
- No skirts, dresses, or shorts that are hemmed higher than two inches above the knee
- No clothing with the pockets torn so as to allow access beneath the garment
- No metal hair ornaments
- No khaki or beige clothing which could be mistaken for inmate clothing
- No camouflage, Army/Navy clothing
- Nursing scrubs/uniforms will no longer be allowed in the visiting room.
- No jewelry except wedding bands and/or engagement rings
- No under wire bras which set off the metal detector
- Undergarments must be worn
- No clothing which in the opinion of the Visiting Room Lieutenant appears provocative or inappropriate
- No hooded clothing
- Visitors who are unable to pass the metal detector due to a medical condition must provide medical documentation prior to entering the John J. Moran Medium Security Facility. After such documentation is inspected, it will be entered into the computer for subsequent visits.
- No open toe footwear
